



### **Individual Class Enrollment:**

Enrollment in individual classes affords you the opportunity to select the classes you wish to take. As a new student having never attended TRSOM, applicants can enroll in any classes regardless of the year (i.e. second year classes, etc.). Applicants do not need to have taken the first year to individually enroll into a second year class.

TRSOM discounts do not apply when enrolling into classes individually and all fees must be paid prior to the start of class. There is a separate application for enrolling in classes individually.
